The Daily Practices of the Month of Safar

Recite the following with the intention of being protected and safeguarded from difficulties:

1. 3 X Shahadah (Testimony of Faith)

شَهَادَةٌ

أَشْهَدُ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ وَأَشْهَدُ أَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا عَبْدُهُ وَرَسُولُهُ

Ashhadu an la ilaha illallah, wa ashhadu anna Muhammadan `abduhu wa Rasulu.

I bear witness that there is no god but Allah (AJ), and I bear witness that Prophet Muhammad (pbuh) is the servant and the Messenger of Allah.

2. 300X Astaghfirullah (I seek forgiveness from Allah (AJ))

أَسْتَغْفِرُ اللَّهَ

3. 7 X Suratul Fil (The Elephant) (Chapter 105)

سُورَةُ الْفِيلِ

After the recitation, blow on yourself and your family for protection

بِسْمِ اللَّهِ الرَّحْمَنِ الرَّحِيمِ.
أَلَمْ تَرَ كَيْفَ فَعَلَ رَبُّكَ بِأَصْحَابِ الْفِيلِ ﴿١﴾ أَلَمْ يَجْعَلْ كَيْدَهُمْ فِي تَضَلُّلٍ ﴿٢﴾ وَأَرْسَلَ عَلَيْهِمْ طَيْرًا
أَبَابِيلَ ﴿٣﴾ تَرْمِيهِمْ بِحِجَارَةٍ مِّن سِجِّيلٍ ﴿٤﴾ فَجَعَلَهُمْ كَعَصْفٍ مَّأْكُولٍ ﴿٥﴾

"Alam tara kaifa fa'ala rabbuka bi ashaabil feel (1) Alam yaj'al kaidahum fee tadleel (2) Wa arsala `alayhim tairan abaabil (3) Tarmeehim bihijaaratim min sijjeel (4) Faja `alahum ka'asfim m'akool (5)" (Suratul Fil)

"Have you not seen, [O Muhammad (pbuh)], how your Lord dealt with the companions of the elephant? (1) Did He not make their plan/plot go astray? (2) And He sent against them flocks of birds (Swallows), (3) Striking them with stones of baked clay, (4) Then He made them like an empty field of stalks and straw, (of which the corn) has been eaten up. 4. 7 X Ayatul Kursi (Verse of the Throne)

اللَّهُ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا هُوَ الْحَيُّ الْقَيُّومُ ۚ لَا تَأْخُذُهُ سِنَّةٌ وَلَا نَوْمٌ ۚ لَّهُ مَا فِي السَّمَاوَاتِ وَمَا فِي الْأَرْضِ ۗ
مَنْ ذَا الَّذِي يَشْفَعُ عِنْدَهُ إِلَّا بِإِذْنِهِ ۚ يَعْلَمُ مَا بَيْنَ أَيْدِيهِمْ وَمَا خَلْفَهُمْ ۖ وَلَا يُحِيطُونَ بِشَيْءٍ مِّنْ عِلْمِهِ
إِلَّا بِمَا شَاءَ ۚ وَسِعَ كُرْسِيُّهُ السَّمَاوَاتِ وَالْأَرْضَ ۖ وَلَا يَئُودُهُ حِفْظُهُمَا ۚ وَهُوَ الْعَلِيُّ الْعَظِيمُ ﴿٢٥٥﴾
